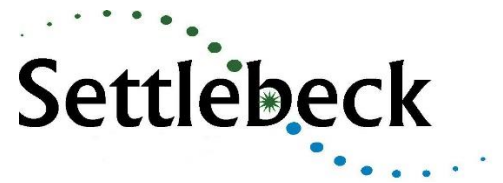

# Destinations Update

We aim to provide a quality careers guidance programme. The success of this can be reflected in the variety of destinations our students progress to Post -16.

We offer a broader approach and seek to ensure that our students are aware of the full range of academic and technical routes available to them.

Destinations are a focus during 1:1 careers interviews, tutorial sessions, assemblies, personal development, Early Help meetings and attendance panels, all of which ensure our students have the information they need.

## Our Strengths

We use destination data, collected at key points throughout KS4 to inform our support for students to ensure that it is bespoke.

- Y10 Work Experience preparation
- PSHE/Careers tutorial sessions
- 1:1 careers interviews
- Y11 post mock examination reviews
- All students in Year 10 have the opportunity to undertake work experience to gain insight into different careers.
- Students prepare for work experience by creating a professional 'CV' and letter of application.
- Year 11 students have the opportunity for 'taster days' at Kendal College and local sixth form providers.
- We have a long standing relationship with Inspira who support our vulnerable students from Year 9.

## Development Priorities

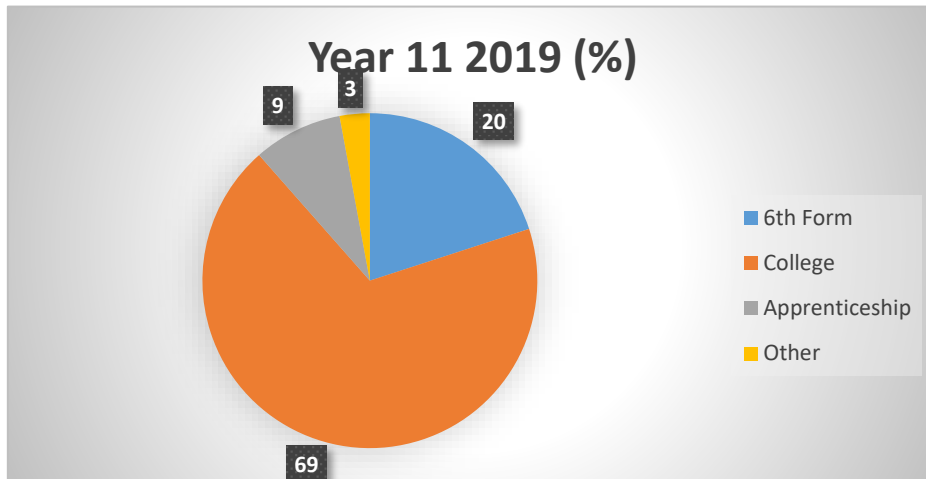
In 2022-23 we aim to develop our careers provision by;

- Re-establishing a mock interview for Year 10 students with local employers (Gatsby Benchmark 5)
- Gatsby benchmark 3 'addressing the needs of each pupil', develop ways to collect and maintain accurate data for each student on their destination for 3 years after they leave.
- Detailed analysis of 'actual' destinations against the 'intended' destinations at KS4
- Developing our relationship with the Cumbria Careers Hub
- Ensuring that students and parents have access to local labour market information.
- Ensuring that careers information is easily accessible on our website
- Address the needs of our students by ensuring that our careers programme raises aspirations of all students and tackles stereotypes (Gatsby Benchmark 3)
- Increase employer encounters for all year groups

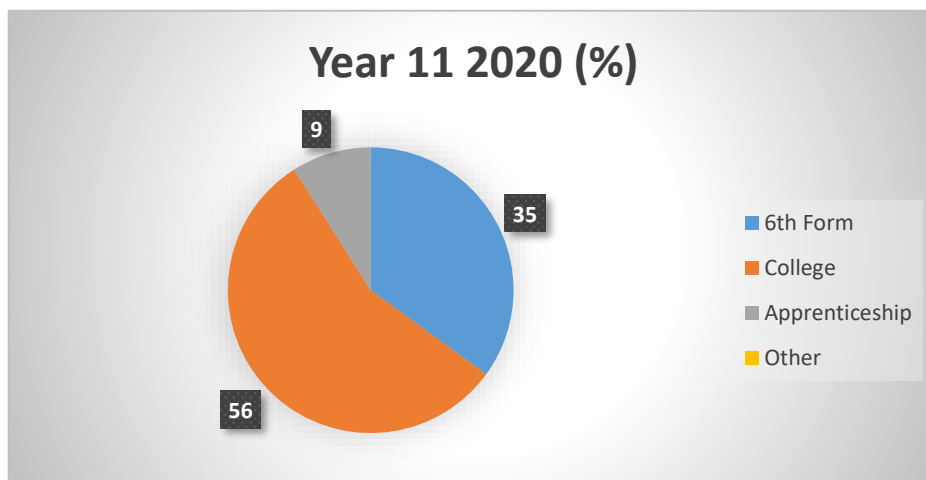
- Increase the access to HE providers allow students to make informed choices about their progression post 16.

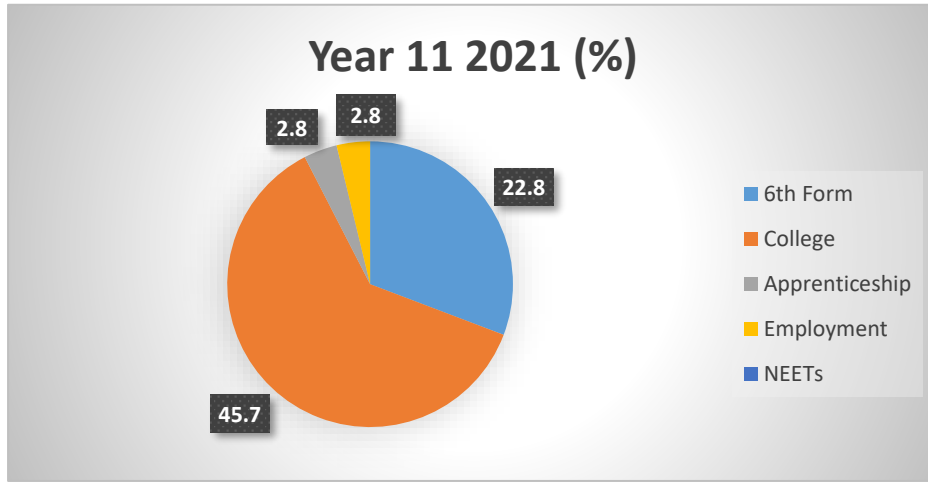
