PROMOTING TOLERANCE

A highlight of last term was the visit from guest speakers, Billy Welch and Bill Lloyd who works closely with the Gypsy Roma Traveller community. This important session gave our students an opportunity to learn about the challenges and cultural richness of these communities. Through this, we were able to promote tolerance, one of the key British Values, encouraging students to appreciate diversity and develop respect for people from all walks of life.
